Articles (1-2)

We, Tamim Bin Hamad Al-Thani, Deputy Emir of the State of Qatar,

Having perused the Constitution; The ratification document issued on the twentieth of the month of Muharram 1432 Hijri, corresponding to 26 December 2010 AD; The proposal of the Council of Ministers; The draft Decree submitted by the Council of Ministers, Hereby decree as follows:

Articles

Article 1

The agreement between the Government of the State of Qatar and the Government of the Republic of Portugal on the abolition of visas for holders of diplomatic and special passports signed in Lisbon on the 4th of May 2010, a copy of which is annexed to this Decree, shall be ratified and shall have the full force of law in accordance with Article 68 of the Constitution.

Article 2

All relevant authorities, each within its field of competence, shall enforce this Decree, which shall come into force on the date of its issuance. This Decree shall be published in the Official Gazette.
